Dear Parents and Carers,

As previously advised the Reception Year Christmas Nativity celebrations are taking place soon and we are so pleased to invite families to share this very special time in the children's lives.

The performances will take place in the Infant School Hall, there is space outside under the canopy to store pushchairs and prams (please do not bring these into the hall). The hall is fully accessible for all visitors. For each performance we ask that no more than two people attend per child, we will not be issuing tickets but rely on your co-operation to ensure that the event is comfortable and safe for all.

Please be mindful that this may be the children's first performance in front of a large adult audience and although exciting it may also be a little daunting for some. The children will be under the care and direction of the class teachers and support staff throughout, if any child does become overwhelmed or upset staff will be there to comfort them.

Filming or taking photographs during the performance will not be allowed. There will be an opportunity for photographs of the classes after their performances. Parents who indicated on their admission forms that they do not want their child to appear in photographs which may be shared on social media or in publications, have received a separate form via Arbor asking them to confirm if they would like them to be included in photographs of this Christmas event.

The performances take place on the following days at 9am, please take your child to their class as normal and then make your way to the Infant School Hall, either through the Year 2 'Secret Garden' or the Poynings Avenue entrance.
