As part of our Religious Education Curriculum the Year Two children will be visiting a local church. The children have the opportunity to visit **Holy Trinity church** where they will explore the building and begin to understand why it is an important place in our community to the Christian faith. This supports the learning that has taken place in the classroom, where the children have been thinking about what makes a place sacred, what worship is, what special and sacred objects are and why it is important to show respect for other peoples precious and sacred belongings.
