Dear Parents/Carers,

We hope the children who have attended our clubs during the year so far have enjoyed the offer that's been put on by staff. We are pleased to continue our club offer into the summer term. **Our clubs will start the week beginning Monday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2025.**

As a school we have tried very hard to keep our 'Hamstel' Clubs free but where there is a small fee this is to cover **the cost of additional resources needed.** We have endeavored to keep this as low as possible. Most of our lunch time clubs will be more fluid with children choosing to attend during their school day, but please see the attached document for what will be on offer.

The **after school clubs run by Hamstel Staff** are offered for the '**whole term**' to allocated year groups. We have rotated our offers to other year groups for the summer term and are pleased to be able to extend our offers to our Reception children. You will be notified of the new offers in time for the new term. Dance Club will continue to run with the same group of children who signed up at the beginning of the year due to committing to being part of the Dance Festival.

Our staff are giving up their time to run and organise these clubs, to ensure they run smoothly and efficiently we ask that your child is **committed to attending weekly** for that term. To support this we recommend you talk to your child about the club they would like to come along to. Please can we also remind you to pick up your child at the correct time, if you are more than 10 minutes late, your child will be put into After School Club and a charge will be applied.

After School Club	Notes
Art	Explore and develop a range of art techniques, using different materials.
Computing	An opportunity to develop some simple coding skills and explore different creative apps.
Cooking	Learn about different foods and how to cook some simple yummy dishes.
Dance	Love music and dancing? Then this is the club for you! Get your dance moves going to some of your favourite tunes, learn some new routines and take part in school events.
Textiles	Get creative and develop different skills using a variety of textiles including some sewing skills.
Well-Being	Take part in some mindfulness activities, connect with others and learn new skills to help us understanding our feelings and relationships.

### Important Information about Hamstel's After School Clubs

Please read the following before booking any after school clubs:

- Please sign up by completing the online club form on the link <https://forms.office.com/e/PXVFek9C4F> by 9am Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> March. Any forms received after this date will only be included if spaces are available.
- Places at all clubs will initially be allocated on a lottery basis in order to make it fairer to everyone.
- Our clubs will run for the whole term; 4 weeks before the half term (3 weeks for Art Club) and 6 weeks after the half term break.
- Please select clubs in order of preference (1<sup>st</sup> choice, 2<sup>nd</sup> choice, 3<sup>rd</sup> choice etc.) on the form so places can be fairly distributed.
- Places in clubs will be limited so if a club becomes oversubscribed, a waiting list will be kept in case places become available at a later date.
- If your child is successful, you will be notified of your child's place in a club via e-mail. Those who have a place in paid clubs will also have a payment request on ParentPay. **In these cases, all fees must be paid for by Friday 4<sup>th</sup> April 2025 or places may be allocated to other children.** Please keep a close eye on your ParentPay.
- Children should be collected promptly at the time the club finishes – collection points to be confirmed - where the Club Leader will bring them to you.
- Please note, if your child receives a place, they will need to attend each week and for the full session, unless the office is informed by a parent/carer through a note, phone call, e-mail or in person. Regular failure to inform the school of non-attendance could result in your child losing their place.
- Regular non-attendance or late collection from after school clubs could also mean your child losing their place.
- If you are more than 10 minutes late, then your child will be placed in After School Club and a charge could be applied.
- If, for any reason, your child no longer requires their place, please let the office know as soon as possible so the place can be offered to someone else.
