HAF FUND (Holiday, Activity & Food) - FREE EASTER ACTIVITIES FOR CHILDREN ENTITLED TO FREE SCHOOL MEALS!

During the Easter break Turning Tides Triple T's project will be delivering on behalf of Southend Borough Council HAF Fund, a number of free activities for children. These activities will take place in their local parks/outdoor spaces, details about the dates/times/drop off and collection arrangements will all be confirmed during the booking process.

During the sessions children will have a chance to take on our Easter egg hunt challenge, to participate in some physical activities such as sports and games and to get creative with our craft and nature sessions. This will be an opportunity for children to meet other like-minded young people who live in their area as well as learning about healthy foods and also try their hand at making their own healthy lunch/dinner.

A meal, snacks and drinks will be provided during the session so no money or food is needed. **Places are limited on a first come first serve basis.** Each session will be 4 hours in length and a maximum number of 15 children on each session. **Children must be between the ages of 7 and 13 and be entitled to benefit-related free school meals.** There will be a maximum of 2 sessions per week per child.

With a focus on mental and physical wellbeing we are hoping to deliver most of our activities outside so appropriate footwear, warm and waterproof clothing will be needed.
