

YEAR 1 BEACH VISIT

April 2026

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our wider Outdoor Learning enrichment the Year 1 children will be visiting our local beach. The children will observe some of the different sea life birds and creatures that can be spotted in the environment, supporting the science learning completed in the classroom. The children will also get stuck into some different outdoor activities and have some fun playing games on the beach. The beach visits will take place on **Tuesday 28th April and Wednesday 29th April**. See below for the day your child's class will be going.

The children will leave at 9.10am and walk down to the beach close to where 'Ocean Beach' is situated, as there are toilet facilities and shelter if needed. The children will return to school after lunch for the normal end of school day.

The school can provide each child with a packed lunch for the trip. Please indicate which lunch option your child would like on the form at this link [YEAR 1 BEACH VISIT: PERMISSION & LUNCH CHOICE – Fill out form](#). **If we do not receive a completed form by Tuesday 21st April you will have to provide a packed lunch from home.** If you would prefer to pack your own child's lunch, we kindly ask that packed lunches are sent in **a labelled, disposable bag** rather than a lunchbox on this occasion. Please follow our usual school lunch guidelines (balanced lunch, no nuts), with a normal lunch portion.

The children will be doing lots of exploring and playing games so they will need to wear sensible old clothes, old trainers. As there is a high chance it will be a warm sunny day, please ensure your child has had sun cream applied before school, shoulders are covered and they have a sun hat. We will provide them with a high-vis vest to wear for the day. Children will also need their water bottle with them.

We would really appreciate your help on the day if you are available, however this must be agreed via the class teacher. **All adults who volunteer must sign in with us on the morning of the trip, have read and agreed to our volunteer guidance to ensure everyone stays safe on the trip.** If you would like to help your child's class on the day of the trip please speak with the class teacher and they will let you know if your help is required.

A completed permission form is required for each child, without this they will not be able to join their classmates on this visit.
