Behaviour Policy – ARC, Zones of Regulation, Dojo's, Consequences	celebrations and the children do something else instead. The ideas were shared that the children at School Council had come up with, the School Council were very positive and are going to take the ideas back to their classes and explore any other ideas. The Parent Council agreed that children having a voice with the outcome of the decision of what to do instead of giving out sweets was felt that this was the best way forward, so everyone was supportive of the decision within the school community. VT explained that as a school we have been reviewing our Behaviour Policy. VT explained briefly the ARC strategy (ask, remind, consequence), that we will be implementing the zones of regulation across the school (colours linked to emotions), we have reviewed how we use the Dojo system to give rewards and we have reviewed the different stages of behaviour linked to consequences. Once this has all be finalized, we will be creating parent friendly leaflets of information.
Dojo at home system, how is working for parents in KS1 since it was launched in January?	Parent Council felt it was a good platform that the children really enjoyed using, being able to communicate with her peers in a safe way and they love the characters. Some classes, particularly in Year 2 have shared some information reminders for the children which has been helpful. As a school could we provide more information about the expectations of what / how to use it for home learning? VT gave a brief explanation about the purpose of it, and stated it's not an extra thing to do or a place where more homework will be provided. Children can upload their spelling work, or anything they would like to share linked to topics, achievements. However sometimes teachers may share some learning the children have carried out that week and if the children want to practice something a bit more, than they

- There seems to be classes opening doors at different times, there is a class that always seems to be the last the door– late by 5 minutes 20 past in the mornings not always open until 8.35am
- Maths / Football events for example how are the children being picked?
- Update on the PTA can we send out some information again VT suggested that the PTA could have a spot on the newsletter and will speak to the Office about this
- Pick up times can it be opened up between 3.10pm and 3.20pm instead of just having 5minues at 3.15pm, this is
