Dear Parents and Carers,

This year we are really pleased to invite families to share the Year 2 Christingle Service with us. Reverend Goodliff will be leading the assembly and the children will be taking part, telling the traditional Christmas story with songs and narrators.

The assemblies will take place in the Infant School Hall, there is space outside under the canopy to store pushchairs and prams (please do not bring these into the hall). The hall is fully accessible for all visitors. For each performance we ask that no more than two people attend per child, we will not be issuing tickets but rely on your co-operation to ensure that the event is comfortable and safe for all.

Please be mindful that performing in front of a large adult audience although exciting may also be a little daunting for some. The children will be under the care and direction of the class teachers and support staff throughout, if any child does become overwhelmed or upset they will be there to comfort them.

The performances take place on the following days at 9am, please take your child to their class as normal and then make your way to the Infant School Hall.
