Dear Parents and Carers,

The Nursery Christmas Nativity celebrations will be taking soon and we are so pleased to invite families to share this very special time in the children's lives.

The performances will take place in the Nursery, which is fully accessible for all visitors. For each performance we ask that no more than two people attend per child, we will not be issuing tickets but rely on your co-operation to ensure that the event is comfortable and safe for all.

Please be mindful that this may be the children's first performance in front of a large adult audience and although exciting it may also be a little daunting for some. The children will be under the care and direction of the staff throughout, if any child does become overwhelmed or upset they will be there to comfort them.

Filming or taking photographs during the performance will not be allowed. There will be an opportunity for photographs after the performances. Parents who indicated on their admission forms that they do not want their child to appear in photographs which may be shared on social media or in publications, will receive a separate form on ParentPay asking them to confirm if they would like them to be included in this Christmas event.

The performances take place on the following days.

- 🌲 **Thursday 14th December at 9.15am** for families of children either on morning sessions or full day sessions

Please bring your child to Nursery at their normal time, for the morning performance you will be invited into Nursery for the performance and for the afternoon performance Poynings Avenue gate will be opened just before 2pm. The gate will close promptly at 2pm to allow staff to be ready for the performance and unfortunately late arrivals will not be able to be admitted.
