

# Hamstel Infant School and Nursery Covid Symptoms Flow Chart



Does your child have either a **temperature** (this means your child feels hot to touch on their chest or back (you do not need to measure their temperature) a **new continuous cough**, (this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if your child usually has a cough, it may be worse than usual) a **loss of taste or smell** (this means your child cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal)?

- If your child has any of the main symptoms of coronavirus:
1. Get a test to check if your child may have coronavirus as soon as possible.
  2. Stay at home and do not have visitors until you get your child's test result – only leave your home to have a test.
  3. Anyone you live with, and anyone in your support bubble, must also stay at home until you get your child's result.

If the parent is unsure we advise the parent to contact 111 for advice and then to contact the school again as a result of that advice.

Does any member of your household have either a temperature, a new continuous cough, loss of taste or smell?

All members of the household stay at home

Member of the household showing symptoms must get a Covid test and others tested only if they show symptoms and **MUST INFORM SCHOOL OF THE RESULT**

**Parent cannot get a test**  
A test must be sought within 5 days of symptoms and in the meantime the child must isolate for 10 days and the whole household and support bubble for 14 days unless test is **negative** for symptomatic person

**If you are contacted by NHS Track and Trace (and your child was with you during contact with someone with Covid-19) you and your child must self-isolate for 14 days from the day you had contact with the person as it can take 14 days for symptoms to appear. Other people in your household/**

Your child has to stay at home for 10 days and everyone in your household or support bubble must self-isolate for 14 days. Please inform school as soon as possible.

If your child is well and temperature has gone

Child /adult who tests positive stays at home for 10 days but all other members have to stay at home for 14 days

Your child can return to school

If a child has any Covid-19 symptoms they cannot return to school without receiving the test and the result of the test has been shared with the school.
