Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 1 Outdoor Learning Invitation

As you are aware we have been working hard to further develop our Outdoor Learning offer and it plays a fundamental part of our curriculum and enrichment offer. We would like to invite parents/carers to join their child in part of their Outdoor Learning session the **week beginning 18th May 2026**. This will give you an opportunity to spend some time with your child in this well-loved space as well as take part in some activities with the class and staff. It will give you a snapshot of some of the learning the children participate in with their peers.

The table below shows the day you are invited to join a session. **The session will run from 2pm - 3pm**. We will open Poyning's Gate entrance for you to enter through, please ensure to arrive by 2pm as late entry will not be possible. You will then be escorted to the Wildlife Area to meet your child and their class. Once the session is over the children will need to return to their classroom to change shoes and get their things to go home. We will ask you to wait outside the classroom door whilst the staff help the children get ready, then the children will be released.

We ask that **only 1 adult per child** attends the session and **no younger siblings** come along, this is to ensure that everyone is able to keep safe whilst outside. **Whilst on site and in the Wildlife Area we ask that you remain with your child and the class**. If there is an emergency and you need to leave, then you must inform staff and they will escort you off site. **We also ask that mobile phones are on silent and no photos are taken during the visit**. Please make sure you are wrapped up if it is cold and old trainers / wellies are advisable if wet.

We hope you enjoy the Outdoor Learning session with your child and their class. Mrs Shine and the Year 2 team look forward to welcoming you on the day.
