After School Club	Notes
Art	Explore and develop a range of art techniques, using different materials.
Cooking	Learn about different foods and how to cook some simple yummy dishes.
Dance	Dance Club will continue with the same group of children who signed up at the beginning of the year due to being part of the Dance Festival in May. A communication will be sent out before May half term to invite some different children for the last part of the summer.
Craft	Enjoy getting crafty? Then come and long and be part of making and exploring different crafts, using a range of materials.
Well-Being	Take part in some mindfulness activities, connect with others and learn new skills to help us understanding our feelings and relationships.
Maths Games	An opportunity to practice some maths skills and play different maths games, making learning and practicing maths fun.
Singing	If you enjoying singing, then this is a chance to come together and sing songs and enjoy music. We will learn new songs and sometimes use instruments to accompany them.

Important Information about Hamstel's After School Clubs

Please read the following before booking any after school clubs:

Please sign up by completing the online club form on the link [SUMMER TERM 2026 CLUB OFFERS – Fill out form](#) by **9am Wednesday 18th March 2026**. Any forms received after this date will only be included if spaces are available.

- Places at all clubs will initially be allocated on a lottery basis in order to make it fairer to everyone.
- Our clubs will run for the whole term in a 6 week block for first half and then a 6 week block the other side of the half term break.
- Please select clubs in order of preference (1st choice, 2nd choice, 3rd choice etc.) on the form so places can be fairly distributed.
- Places in clubs will be limited so if a club becomes oversubscribed, a waiting list will be kept in case places become available at a later date.
- If your child is successful, you will be notified of your child's place in a club via e-mail. Those who have a place in paid clubs will also see a payment request on Arbor. **All fees must be paid for by Friday 10th April 2026 or places may be allocated to other children.** Please keep a close eye on your Arbor.
- **Children should be collected promptly at the time the club finishes. If you are more than 10 minutes late, then your child will be placed in After School Club and a charge applied.**
- Please note, if your child receives a place, they will need to attend each week and for the full session, unless the office is informed by a parent/carer through a note, phone call, e-mail or in person. Regular failure to inform the school of non-attendance could result in your child losing their place.
- Regular non-attendance or late collection from after school clubs could also mean your child losing their place.
- **If, for any reason, your child no longer requires their place, please let the office know as soon as possible so the place can be offered to someone else.**
