Week One and Two: Supertato

Key Book: Supertato!

This week we will be kicking off our Superhero topic with the Supertato books. I wonder what things Evil Pea will get up to during these weeks?

Week Three: Fictional Superheroes

This week we will be following the children's interests and learning about the Superheroes that the children are interested in.

Week Three: Transport Heroes

Our theme this week will be Transport Heroes. The children will role play some 'naughty' activities with the toy bus and take pictures of all the naughty things their bus gets up to!

Week Five: Historic Superheroes

Key Book: George and the Dragon

This week we will be learning about the story of George and Dragon. We will be learning to write a set of instructions to trap the Dragon!

Week Four: Real Life Superheroes

Key Text: Burglar Bill and non-fiction books

We will think about all the real-life superheroes that help us on a daily basis. We will be exploring non-fiction books about real life superheroes and writing our own information text.

Week Seven: I am a Superhero

Key Book: Super Duper You

This week we will be thinking about all the things we have achieved this year.

We will continue to have our daily RWInc lessons.

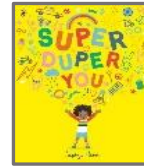
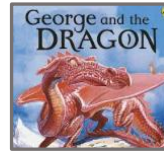
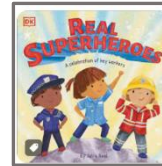
In Writing we will be focusing on thinking of our sentence, holding in our heads and writing it down. We will be encouraging the children to use WOW words (descriptive words) to make their sentences more interesting as well as capital letters, spaces and full stops.

Handwriting

We will be continuing our daily handwriting lessons, learning to write capital letters as well as reviewing all the letter families. During all our writing activities will be focusing on forming our letters correctly as well as trying to position them on a line correctly.

Maths

Doubling

We will be learning to understand that double means twice as many. We will be building doubles using objects and saying the doubles e.g Double 2 is 4.

Sharing and Grouping

This week we will be learning to share out items equally so there is the same amount.



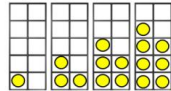
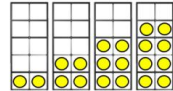
6 in 2 equal groups



6 in groups of 2 (pairs)

Even and Odd

We will learn that some quantities will share equally into 2 groups and some won't. We will start to recognise the odd and even structure using number shapes.



Deepening Understanding

Towards the end of the term we will start to engage in problem solving, thinking about how to solve a problem and finding ways to find a solution.

Patterns and Relationships

We will be learning to copy, continue and create repeating patterns.



Oracy

This half-term we will be focusing the four strands of oracy:

Physical: Speak audibly so they can be heard and understood by the class.

Cognitive: To explain how or why something happened using 'because' or 'so'.

Linguistic: To use if and might to explain how they could improve their work next time.

Social and Emotional: To take turns to speak when working in learning partners.

PE – Attack v Defence

Taking turns playing games, keeping score, following rules, avoiding defenders, preventing attackers, learning mini games and preparation for Sports Day.

Fine Motor Skills

Hand and Finger strength: ripping thick card

Wrist stability and movement: opening and closing jars, twisting nuts and bolts

Finger isolation: touching finger to thumb on both hands

In hand manipulation: rolling pencils between fingers

Crossing the midline: drawing big rainbow shapes across a page

Pincer grip: threading beads

Geography – Seasonal Changes

Changes from Spring to Summer, type of weather associated with Summer and the features of Summer.

My local area – learning the name of the road and city that our school is in. Describing aerial views of our local area, drawing maps of our school.

RE – What is special about our world?

Art – Collage

Exploring tearing and cutting materials, layering and overlapping materials, selecting colours and textures for effect, creating a superhero college scene.

How to help at home
