### School Admission Transfers for Year 3 – September 2021

We are writing to inform all parents whose children are in year 2 about the admission arrangements for transfer to year 3. There are different arrangements for children currently attending infant schools and those attending primary schools, therefore please read carefully.

### Is your child in year 2 at an infant school?

All children in year 2 that are attending an infant school **must apply** to Southend on Sea Borough Council for transfer to year 3 in 2021, by 15 January 2021. This is the law and transfer is not automatic. A summary information sheet is provided overleaf.

### Is your child in a primary school?

Children continuing in the same primary school will **not** need to apply to transfer to year 3.

Only submit an application if you wish to change schools for year 3 or if you are in an infant school by the 15 January 2021.

If you are a resident in Southend and pay council tax to Southend-on-Sea Borough Council you can make an application by using the Council on-line facility at: <a href="https://www.southend.gov.uk/admissions">www.southend.gov.uk/admissions</a> if you are not a resident please submit an application to your home authority.

The closing date for both on-line and paper applications for **Reception year and Year 3** is **15 January 2021.**

### Key information transition to year 3

- ➤ Children in year 2 at **infant schools** must apply to transfer to year 3 at the junior school. Apply any time between 14 September 2020 and 15 January 2021.
- Children in primary schools that are not changing schools do not need to apply and move to year 3 without any administrative process.

- 4. Pupils who live in the catchment area
- 5. Pupils who live outside the catchment area who have a sibling attending the school or Bournes Green Infant school
- 6. Remaining applications

### Chalkwell Hall Junior - Published Admission Number (PAN): 120

- 1. Looked after children and previously looked after children
- 2. Pupils attending year 2 at Chalkwell Hall Infant school
- 3. Pupils who live in the catchment area who have a sibling attending the school or Chalkwell Hall Infant
- 4. Pupils of Staff at the school
- 5. Pupils who live in the catchment area
- 6. Pupils who live outside the catchment area who have a sibling attending the school or Chalkwell Hall Infant school
- 7. Pupils who live outside the catchment area

#### Hamstel Junior - Published Admission Number (PAN): 150

- 2. Pupils attending Hamstel Infant school
- 3. Pupils who live in the catchment area who have a sibling attending the school or Hamstel Infant school
